

BOIL WATER NOTICE

Loss of pressure in *part of* Liberty Village water system

PWS ID NY5203329

Consumers of the Liberty Village water supply at 300 to 364 Lily Pond Rd in the Town of Liberty, Sullivan County should boil all water for drinking and culinary purposes.

Peak water demand from users connected the watermain between Upper Lily Pond Road and the Village boundary have caused the water pressure in the service lines serving the above noted addresses to fall below the Sanitary Code-required pressure for longer than 4 hours.

Bring the water to a rolling boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using it. or use bottled water certified for sale by the New York State Department of Health. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation **until further notice**. Boiling kills most microbes and other organisms in the water.

Harmful microbes in drinking water can cause diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms and may pose a special health risk for infants, some elderly, and people with severely compromised immune systems. But these symptoms are not just caused by microbes in drinking water. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you should seek medical advice.

What is being done?

The village is currently reporting that the water level in the storage tank at the Lily Pond Water Plant has reached maximum operating level and water pressure for impacted customers is now returning to normal conditions. You will be informed when tests show that you no longer need to boil your water.
